Liszt Ferenc International Airport to Tokaj and back by train

1. From Liszt Ferenc International Airport to the Train station

By taxi: Reservations can be made in person at the Főtaxi booths located at the exits at Terminals 2A and 2B (follow the painted signs on the floor in the arrival hall). At the taxi rank in front of the stands, taxis are parking continuously waiting for passengers. All cars are equipped with a POS terminal, therefore credit cards are also accepted. Taxis operates at a fixed tariff of 280 HUF/Km (0.95 EUR/Km) in addition to the one-off basic fee of 450 HUF (1.50 EUR) and waiting fee. A ride to the city center should typically cost around 6500 HUF (22 EUR) depending on traffic conditions.

By public transport to “Keleti Pályaudvar” train Station:

Take **Bus no. 200E** (frequency approx. 7-10 minutes), get off at terminal station "Kőbánya-Kispest", change to **Metro line M3** till “Kálvin tér”, change to **Metro line M4** (towards “Keleti Pályaudvar”) and get off at the last stop “Keleti Pályaudvar”. The approximate journey time is 1 hour.

By public transport to “Nyugati Pályaudvar” train Station:

Take **Bus no. 200E** (frequency approx. 7-10 minutes), get off at terminal station "Kőbánya-Kispest", change to **Metro line M3** and get off at stop “Nyugati Pályaudvar”. The approximate journey time is 1 hour.

Tickets are available at the airport. Search for the ticket machine in bus station 200E. You have to validate your ticket on the bus. You have to buy separate ticket for metro (validate before entering the station), however you can change from one metro line to another one as many times as you wish with one ticket, as long as you do not leave the metro stop.

By shuttle: Airport Shuttle minibus service operates between the airport and any location in Budapest. Special rates are available for airport-hotel travels. Tickets can be purchased at the desk on arrival in the baggage reclaim hall (follow the painted signs on the floor in the arrival hall). 2. From Budapest Train Station to Tokaj by train or back

Both from **Keleti and Nyugati train stations** you can take direct trains to **Tokaj**. Tickets are available at the station. For selecting a suitable option and checking the timetable, please visit one of the following websites:

The journey from **Keleti train station** is around 2h 40min, while from **Nyugati train station** is around 3h 20min.

Direct trains leave in every 2 hours both from Keleti (first at 7:30, last at 19:30) and **Nyugati train stations** (first at 6:23, last at 14:23), however, there are high number of services, running all day long, which imply one or more changes of trains.
